## **HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES COMMUNITY LEADERSHIP BURSARY PROGRAM**

McGill Retention bursaries are directed towards students in fields identified as problem areas for access to services in English and are not limited to students from selected regions. Students who receive these bursaries must commit to working in public health institutions or related organizations in the Montérégie East for one year for each year that they are funded. Bursaries can be applied for and administered through MEPEC (Montérégie East Partnership for the English-speaking community)

### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

The Retention Bursary is open to students residing in the Montérégie East who:

- are Canadian citizens(or permanent residents) who have resided in their home region for at least 2 years (24 months)
- have the appropriate English and French language skills to provide health and social services in a health and social services institution in Quebec
- are pursuing studies in a government recognized educational institution located INSIDE or OUTSIDE their home region
- are currently accepted into or pursuing full-time studies in a government recognized health and social services program that permits the students to work professionally in Quebec upon completion of studies; this program of study must prepare them for careers where they will be providing direct care and service; refer to list of Eligible Program of Study in Health and Social Services (see list below)
- are registered full-time during the 2021-2022 Academic Year
- are committed, following completion of studies, to working in their home region, or catchment area of the Montérégie East Partnership for the English-speaking community, in a public health and social services institution or related organization for a minimum of one year per bursary awarded
- agree to participate in any follow-up, monitoring or evaluation of the Program conducted by Dialogue McGill and / or the community network Please note that the Bursary Program is not available to students registered in independent study programs, programs that do not lead
